Bus passes and rail passes increase job opportunities for Southwestern Connecticut workers

(Bridgeport, CT) – July 13, 2007 -- For many people, transportation to and from job interviews and work can be a major barrier in getting and keeping a job. But thanks to the **People to Jobs Regional Transportation Task Force**, if you are looking for work and living in Southwestern Connecticut without personal transportation, there's help available.

“People to Jobs can help you alleviate the financial strain of employment transportation through our Job Start Transportation Assistance Program,” said Program Manager Debbie Venditti. “We provide free bus passes and rail passes to help you get to and from work for your first 30 days of employment.”

The **Job Start Transportation Assistance Program**, funded by the **Connecticut Department of Social Services**, has been helping workers in Southwestern Connecticut since 2003. In addition to passes, workers receive additional benefits offered through partnering agencies: the **Southwestern CTWorks Career Centers** in Bridgeport, Stamford, and Derby, the **Connecticut Department of Labor**, and the **Connecticut Department of Social Services**. These benefits include job placement, career planning, on-the-job training, seminars and access to computers for resumes and job searches.

Bus and rail passes are available to families with dependent children currently receiving or eligible to receive Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) benefits from the Connecticut Department of Social Services. For information, call the **CTWorks Career Center** at (203) 333-5129, x365.
